Judges and Guest Speakers

Giuseppe Colombo Manfroni - Italy (Adapted from Il Bracco Italiano arte e storia)

Born in Milan in 1942. From a young age I had an intensive passion for lyric music. Maybe an old article by Edmondo Amaldi in which he compared the Italian Bracco to the classic music, let grow in me the interest for this breed. In 1965 I bought from Amaldi my first Bracco. In 1969 I bred my first litter which produced Altea which trained and drove by myself, during her long career, acquired all the titles in training and beauty. In 1971 under the name "delle Crode" I felt mature enough to start to deal more generally with the race in whose potential I firmly believed. Having been a member of SABI since 1966 I soon joined the Board of Directors for the purpose of promoting the development and knowledge of the breed. For 25 years I took charge of different roles of the agricultural sector. In 2002 I went to spend my retirement in Val di Sole (Sun Dale) where I dedicated myself to the renewal of the historic home of the Manfroni family. It is now considered one of the largest and most advanced in Val di Sole. Returning to my interest in the dog world, I remember how in 1974, precisely the Italian Bracco, race that I had used in hunting and dog demonstrations and that I had studied in depth, opened for me the doors to a brilliant career as a judge, both for the test of all the pointing breeds from hounds to spaniels and retrievers. I was the favorite pupil of the great master Paolo Ciceri who left me teaching of immeasurable value. My activity as a judge took me all around Italy and Europe allowing me to deepen my knowledge of dogs and that remains true today, like my master said, "from nature and animals you will never stop learning". During the 90s I was part of the ENCI. There were years of strong commitment to SABI first as vice president, then as President. In 1994 I passed the direction of SABI to others to open up the way for further contribution and other ideas by new characters. Recently I again took charge constantly of a place on the Board of Directors, then again the Presidency being considered the technical referent for the breed.



Camille McArdle, DVM- AKC Open Show Judge Camille McArdle's

enjoyment of animals began in childhood with horses, dogs, and guinea pigs. After working some years on the racetracks in south Florida, she entered The Ohio State University as an Animal Science major and eventually earned her Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine, as well as a healthy love of football. Dr. McArdle worked as a racing regulatory veterinarian for a decade, in companion-animal practice for another 12 years, as Dean of Veterinary Technology for a network of 21 career schools, and in shelter medicine at Minneapolis Animal Care & Control since early 2015. She was appointed to the Minnesota Racing Commission in 1993 and is presently in her 26th year as a Commissioner. Camille obtaining her first bloodhound in 1989. Since then she has bred six generations of champion bloodhounds, as well as two basset hound litters with several champions from those litters. Five years ago a Spinone Italiano joined the household. She met her first Braccho at the Spinone National that year and immediately became fascinated with the breed. She began judging in 2007 and is now approved by the American Kennel Club to judge all hound breeds as well as some sporting and working breeds.



Amanda Inman- Health & Kidney Seminars

Amanda Inman is a small animal veterinarian who has owned and bred Bracco Italiano dogs for the past thirteen years. In 2007, she co-founded the Bracco Italiano Club of America and served as the club's first president. She is currently the club's President as well as chairperson of the Judges' Education Committee, and on the committee for the Bracco Italiano Health Foundation. She attended vet school at the University of Florida. After graduation, she spent another year at the university for intensive training in critical care, emergency, and internal medicine. She currently practices in north-central Florida as a hospice veterinarian.

- Birds to be released in all levels –Chukar will be used
- Everyone participating in these tests or entering the field MUST wear an article of Blaze Orange clothing
- Everyone must check in with the hunt chair prior to the running of their level- start times are dependent on entries and running order may need to be changed to keep things flowing, please try to be a little early!
- Each dog will run individually so day of run is determined by number of entries, level could be split over multiple days if necessary
- Beginner will NOT have any live fire, cap pistol only
- Intermediate and Advance will have birds shot if a safe shot can be made
- All shooting of birds will be done by club appointed gunners only- handlers will not carry a gun capable of live fire.
- Intermediate is not required to be steady to shot and fall but the score will reflect higher if they are, they should retrieve a shot bird
- Advance should be a “finished gun dog” who is steady to wing, shot, fall with a retrieve of bird
- GPS tracking collars will be allowed but the receiver MUST be left with the field marshal during the evaluation

Each participant will receive a written evaluation card from the judge.

Placements 1st-4th in each level. Placements determined by highest 4 scores in each level

Best in Field will be awarded a custom bronze Bracco Italiano trophy, sponsored by BICA.

Best in field will be selected by Mr. Manfroni from the three 1st place winners.

Running order will be emailed the Monday prior to the evaluation as well as posted at the meet and greet and at the show site Friday prior to the hunt.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. Dog Show 101

A guide to assist you in choosing the right class(es)

Junior Showmanship- For any handler under age 18. Class is judged on the handler's skills

All Classes divided by sex:

Regular classes (dogs must be intact):

4-6 Month Puppy- Open to any dog that is at least 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the show (note offered in AKC show)

6-9 Month Puppy -Open to any dog that is at least 6 months and under 9 months on the day of the show

9-12 Month Puppy -Open to any dog that is at least 9 months and under 12 months on the day of the show

Bred By Exhibitor *- Dogs that are 6 months of age or older as of the day of the show. Must be bred by and owned or co-owned by exhibitor. Must be shown by the breeder/owner from start to finish of show.

American Bred- dogs 6 months or older who were bred and whelped in the USA.

Open- Open to all dogs 12 months or older

Non-Regular Classes:

Field Titled – Open to any intact dog or bitch who has earned a hunting title through AKC, NAVHDA, UKC as of the date entries close (proof of title should be included with entry)

Veteran- Open to any dog 7 years and older, dogs do not need to be intact

Altered-spayed or neutered only- Not eligible for Best of Breed

Stud Dog (3 get max) This class evaluates the stud on the consistency and type of get produced by the stud

Brood Bitch (3 get max) This class evaluates the bitch on the consistency and type of get produced by the bitch

For stud dog/brood bitch classes:

Offspring (get) must be intact

The owner of the sire or dam need not be the owner of the offspring

Offspring are only judged on their merit

A castrated male may be entered as a stud dog or a spayed bitch may be entered as a brood bitch

The handler of each dog must wear an armband number

Double entering of classes: You may enter classes your dog/bitch is eligible for however if you enter more than one class- you must remain undefeated in order to go to Best of Breed. As an example: if you enter Bred By and Open if you do not win both classes you are no longer eligible to move on to Best of Breed (for best in show) being defeated in either class negates a win in the other.
